#### **Just.Mattresses Recycling Information:**

- We accept mattresses, mattress toppers, and box springs; we do not accept bed frames or futon frames.

#### **FEES:**

Justice Industries charges for labor, pickup and delivery to [Spring Back Recycling](#), our non-profit partner organization that recycles mattresses. Our fees are on a per piece basis, a piece being either a box spring or a mattress (king sets are usually 3 pieces: a mattress & a 2-piece box spring).

- \* \$65 for one piece
- \* \$75 for two pieces
- \* \$85 for three pieces
- \* \$95 for four pieces

#### **PROCESS:**

- Please place your pieces outside near your door, on a porch, deck, or patio.
  - If paying by check, place your payment in a zip lock bag and pinned to the mattress.
  - To pay with a card, use Venmo @justiceindustries.
  - Items for recycling do not have to be clean or in good condition.
- IF your pieces are less than five years old, in good condition, stain-free, and can be reused, we are happy to take it to Williamson County based charity, [Graceworks](#), for an additional \$25 travel surcharge. Williamson County residents may call directly (615)794-9055, to arrange pick up at no charge.

#### **AREAS SERVED:**

- We offer service to Nashville zip code residents. If you live outside of the Nashville zip code area, but are located in Davidson or Williamson County, there will be an additional \$25 travel surcharge fee.
